$$\text{Cost of Education} - \text{Family Contribution} = \text{Estimated Financial Need}$$

Your family contribution is determined by the U.S. Department of Education from the information you provided on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Our financial aid award to you attempts to meet your estimated financial need as closely as possible.
