Summer is considered the final semester of the 2008-2009 award year; therefore **summer financial aid is very limited**. A student's eligibility for summer aid is generally the amount of annual eligibility remaining or not used during the fall and spring semesters.

Important Information Regarding Financial Aid for Summer

- **You must be registered at least half-time to be eligible for federal aid. Half-time is determined by the total number of registered hours in *all* summer sessions.**
 - Undergraduate Students: full-time = 12 credits; $\frac{3}{4}$ time = 9 credits; $\frac{1}{2}$ time = 6 credits
 - Graduate Students: full-time = 9 credits; $\frac{1}{2}$ time = 4 credits
- **The first disbursement of federal loan proceeds will not credit your account until you have reached the mandatory status of half-time enrollment.**
- **Alternative loans are available to students enrolled less than half-time, half-time or full time**

Eligibility Requirements for Federal Summer Aid

- You must be an admitted/registered John Carroll student.
- You must have completed the 2008-2009 FAFSA and the 2009 Summer Aid Application.
- You must be registered at least half-time to be eligible for federal aid. Half-time is determined by the total number of registered hours in *all* summer sessions.

Summer School Cost of Attendance

Your Cost of Attendance for the summer session must be calculated in order to determine your financial aid eligibility. Your summer budget will be determined by combining the actual costs of tuition and fees for all intended summer sessions with the cost of all other budget components including room and board, books and supplies, transportation, and personal expenses.

Summer Session Financial Aid Eligibility

Pell Grant: Students who are eligible for Pell Grant and did not attend full-time for both fall '08 and spring '09 semesters may be eligible to receive Pell grant in the summer.

Stafford Loans: Students who have not borrowed their full annual limits during the fall '08 and spring '09 semesters may have remaining Stafford Loan eligibility for summer. Annual limits are based on the year in school as measured by cumulative credits.

Plus Loans: Parents may apply for a PLUS loan for their dependent undergraduate student if the student will be enrolled at least half-time or more throughout any/all of the five summer sessions.

Grad Plus Loans: Graduate students who have borrowed all of their Stafford Loan eligibility and who are enrolled at least half-time or more throughout any/all of the five summer sessions may apply for the Grad Plus Loan.

Alternative Loans: Students who are not eligible for federal aid or who need additional funding options may apply for an alternative loan. Alternative loans are available for any student enrolled either less than half-time, half-time or full time. Information concerning alternative loans is available in the Office of Financial Aid.
