ETHICS (PARTIAL)**Guidelines for Course Development Grants**

The Partial Summer Ethics Course Development Fellowship provides a stipend to revise currently-existing courses by integrating an ethics component into them. The purpose of the Fellowship is to encourage faculty to restructure their courses to include the ethical issues which arise in their discipline.

This Fellowship is a partial fellowship; recipients are expected to complete their project during the period beginning after commencement in May and ending with the start of Fall Semester. All full-time tenured or tenure-track faculty are eligible to apply. The stipends have a \$1,000 value.

Recipients are required to submit a written report on the results of the award including a completed syllabus, list of materials and bibliography. There should also be a plan to evaluate the course. The report should be submitted to the Associate AVP for Academic Programs and Faculty Diversity by October 1st following the award period. Courses which are developed are expected to be offered during the following academic year.

Applications should be made on the "Summer Course Development Fellowship" form available in the Office of the Academic Vice President and at WWW.JCU.EDU/AVP/FD.

Deadline for applications is **Monday, February 7, 2011**.
