The UCC recommends imposing a limit on the number of transient courses counting for Core credit. We recommend that after matriculation at JCU, the limit be 18 credit hours of transient courses counting for Core.

Rationale:

The Core curriculum is an essential part of the Jesuit education offered at John Carroll. Therefore it is essential that a significant proportion of the courses that count toward the Core be taken at John Carroll. We do not wish to impose hardships on transfer students or penalize those who enter with AP credits, so we propose that the limit affect only those courses taken after matriculation. A limit of 18 credits, roughly one-third of the Core, would allow for a full semester of study abroad.
