Gergely Bogányi will perform works by Ferenc Liszt in this special 200th anniversary of his birth, as well as by Frédéric Chopin, whose interpretation is his specialty. His brilliant technique, coupled with a deeply expressed artistic interpretation, has made him an outstanding international performer. He has become one of the most sought-after Hungarian pianists of his generation, having played the concert halls of Europe, China, and Japan, with major orchestras such as the London Philharmonic. Born in Vác, Hungary in 1972, he started playing the piano at the age of four. He continued his studies at the Liszt Academy (Budapest),

the Sibelius Academy (Helsinki) and at Indiana University (Bloomington, IN). In addition to the Kossuth prize, Hungary's highest artistic honor, he has been awarded the Liszt Prize by the Ministry of Cultural Heritage, Budapest; Cross of Merit of the White Rose of Finland by the President of the Finnish Republic. In 2011, his weekend marathon of ten concerts, Chopin's complete piano works, received the Hungarian Gramofon Prize, category of "Best concert event and performing artist in Hungary".
