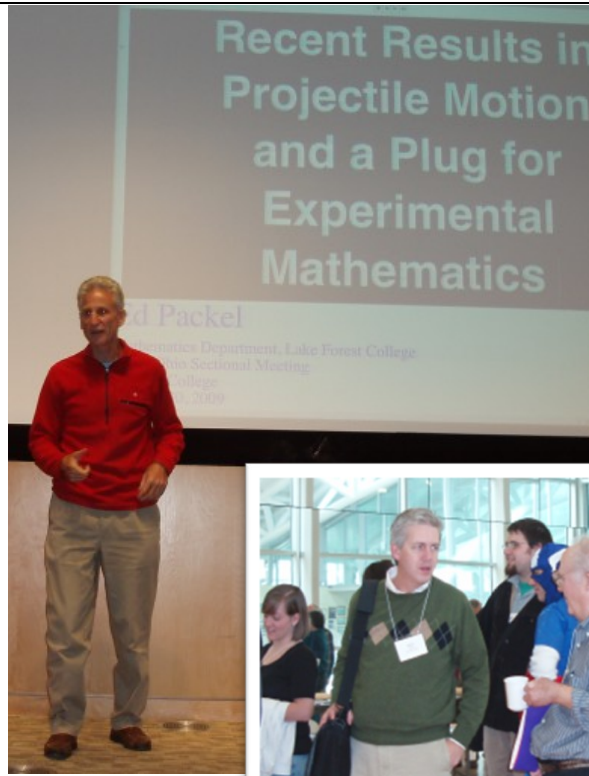




Mini-Ohio Focus

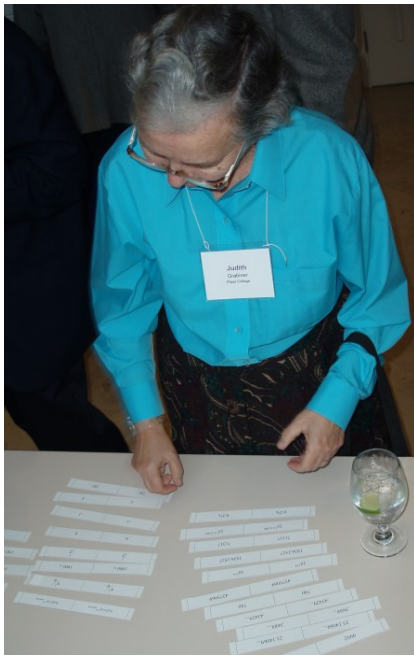


The fall Ohio Section meeting was held at Kenyon College on October 30-31, 2009.



During the break on Friday afternoon, people visited and browsed the book exhibits.



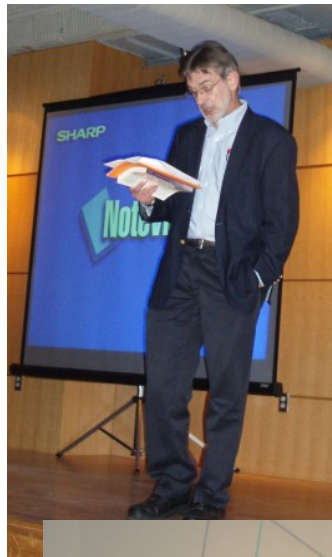


Before the Friday evening banquet, meeting participants had to choose numbers for the drawing of doorprizes.
