

RESPONSIBLE CONDUCT OF RESEARCH TRAINING PROCEDURES

John Carroll University is committed to the ethical conduct of research and is in compliance with Section 7009 of the America Creating Opportunities to Meaningfully Promote Excellence in Technology, Education and Science (America COMPETES) Act.

Researchers will complete one RCRT form for each student/post doc (“employee”) who will be working on an NSF funded grant project. The researcher will be responsible for ensuring RCR training to the employee in the project-applicable areas in accordance with the subject discipline.

Assistance in training, along with additional resources, are provided by the Office of Sponsored Research & Research.

The completed form should be sent to the Office of Sponsored Research & Research Compliance, AD 250.
