ADMISSION PROCESS AND APPLICATION DEADLINES

113 Submit letter(s) of recommendation

 At least one letter of recommendation is required from a teacher or counselor.

APPLICATION DEADLINES AND NOTIFICATION

November 15

Early Action and priority scholarship deadline. All components of the application as listed above must be received by this date. Although we may begin notification earlier, anyone who meets the Early Action deadline will receive their admission decision by mid-December.

Post November 15

Rolling admission. Decisions are released weekly beginning in mid-January.

Post February 1

Rolling admission on a space-available basis.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Students will automatically be considered for merit scholarships up to \$26,000 upon applying for admission. Merit awards are determined based on academic performance, rigor of high school curriculum, and standardized test scores (if submitted). Scholarships (below) are annual, renewable amounts.

 MAGIS SCHOLARSHIP
 \$25,000 to \$26,000

 PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP
 \$21,000 to \$24,000

 UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP
 \$15,000 to \$20,000

IGNATIAN AWARD Up to \$13,000

Listed scholarship values automatically renew for a total of four years, as long as academic and conduct standards are maintained. Students are notified of their scholarship at the time of admission.

IGNATIAN HERITAGE SCHOLARSHIP

Admitted students are eligible to apply for our Ignatian Heritage Scholarship. The first-place winner will receive a full-tuition scholarship. The second-place winner will receive free room & board. The third-place winner will receive a \$3,000 Mathews Scholarship.

LEGACY GRANT

The Legacy Grant is available exclusively to first-year and transfer legacy students enrolling at JCU in fall 2023. Eligible legacy students will automatically qualify to receive this \$1,000 grant that will renew for four years.

FINANCIAL AID

Families are strongly encouraged to file the FAFSA to be considered for additional institutional grant assistance, federal or state aid, loans, and/or student employment. JCU's FAFSA code is 003050. FAFSA results have no influence on admission decisions. We anticipate beginning to release financial aid awards in February.
