Students who are required by law to obtain a state license at the end of their degree program will have a licensure allowance added to their cost of attendance in their final year.

Students registered for less than 12 credit hours per semester will be assessed at a per credit hour rate of \$1,630 and in most cases financial aid will be adjusted accordingly. The Undergraduate Summer 2023 rate per credit hour is \$815.

Please note that the amount of financial aid awarded cannot exceed the total cost of education.
