John Carroll University Integrative Core Curriculum guide for Cuyahoga Community College courses

The following are courses that will transfer in to JCU and satisfy our integrative core curriculum requirements. However, certain majors may require students to take particular courses to fulfill certain core requirements. The list of JCU majors can be searched at bulletin.jcu.edu/programs and the most up-to-date, full listing of transfer courses and their JCU equivalents can be found at jcu.edu/registrar/servicesand-forms. The following guide is for reference only and the information is subject to change and will be updated as these changes arise. It is highly recommended that students interested in completing a JCU degree begin working with a JCU Transfer Specialist as early as possible; Transfer Specialists can be reached through the Office of Admission at 216.397.4294.

Of note, students who transfer 45 or more semester credit hours to JCU are eligible for an abbreviated transfer student core curriculum, which waives the foreign language, distribution, and some of the foundational competencies below—though that which is remaining must be taken at JCU and cannot be transferred in. Students may only transfer up to 60 credits from a community college toward their JCU degree.
