Program Highlights:

1. Research: Summer I

2. Medical Immersion Trip to Honduras: Summer II

Immerse yourself in a unique medical environment, work alongside healthcare professionals in Honduras, gain a global perspective of healthcare in rural Honduras, and develop cultural competence and an understanding of others.

3. MCAT Preparation:

MCAT preparation materials will be provided to help you achieve your best score and unlock your pathway to medical school.

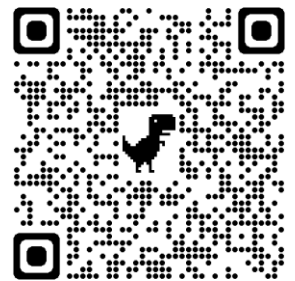
Eligibility – Applicants must be in their first or second year, majoring in Biology or Cell and Molecular Biology, and intend on applying to medical school. A 3.5 or higher GPA is recommended.
