## **History Class & Staff Ride Requirement & Guidelines**

Staff Ride: **The Staff Ride is a commissioning requirement.** The intent of the staff ride is to apply military principles and concepts as they relate to the human dimension of warfare on the terrain of an actual battlefield.

## **Guidelines for your Staff Ride:**

- MS3 & MS4 Cadets are eligible for the staff ride. These trips typically occur in September or October over a weekend. Cadets must plan accordingly within their schedule.
- Professor of Military Science (PMS) to review exceptions on a case-by-case basis. An example
  is participating in a neighboring schools' staff ride or an instructor-evaluated virtual staff ride
  and Battle Analysis.



History Class: All cadets must successfully complete a college level survey course in American military history. The objective is to improve the cadet's understanding of the evolution of warfare, the professionalism of the American military and the place of the American military in society and lessons learned.

## **Guidelines for your History Class:**

- You must take a Military History Course if one is offered at your university or college. If a course
  is not offered, or one does not fit in your schedule, notify your instructor regarding approval of
  an alternative class.
- Alternatives include courses offering the history of major wars in the 19th or 20th century (WWI, WWII, Cold War, etc); history of the United States foreign policy in the 20th century; or another advanced history course as approved by the Professor of Military Science (PMS).
- Any alternative course must be 3 credits and in the 2 or 3 course level preferably. Cadets who
  request an alternative, must show:
  - Why a regular Military History course is not possible
  - How the alternative course meets the intent stated above (provide academic schedule and syllabus as a minimum for documentation)
