Type of Incident(s): Damage to vehicles at 2200 S. Green Road (JFX Lot)

Date/Time of Incident(s): Tuesday, March 19th 1:17am, 2024.

Incident Description: At 7:58 am on Tuesday March 19th 2024 a JCU shuttle driver notified JCUPD to report a vehicle with a window broken out in the student section of the parking lot at 2200 S. Green Road, (JFX lot). The shuttle driver also reported that UHPD officers were already at the parking lot. JCU PD officers responded and met with UHPD officers on scene. While on scene officers identified a second vehicle having a window broken out. All vehicles that were identified as having damage in the lot are those registered to JCU students. UHPD officers advised that there were several other vehicles in the parking lot for the Huntington Green Apartments that were also damaged. All involved JCU students were notified and directed to contact the University Heights Police department to file reports. UHPD officers were able to obtain video footage showing individuals going through the lot at 1:17am

Additional Information: From available information at this time there are no reports of stolen vehicles.

Please remember to lock your cars and do not leave valuables in plain sight. Report suspicious behavior to JCUPD immediately. JCUPD and JCU Security officers will be increasing patrols through the JFX parking lot as well as Lot B at Notre Dame College.
